


Short Biosketch For Eugene Chen



Eugene Chen earned his Ph.D. degree from The University of Massachusetts, Amherst, in 1995, under the direction of late Professors James Chien and Marvin Rausch. After a postdoctoral stint at Northwestern University with Prof. Tobin J. Marks, he joined The Dow Chemical Company in late 1997, where he was promoted from Sr. Research Chemist to Project Leader. He moved to Colorado State University in August 2000. Currently he is the John K.

Stille Chair in Chemistry and the Millennial Professor of Polymer Science and Sustainability.

His current research is focused on polymer science, green & sustainable chemistry, renewable energy, and catalytic chemistry. Selected recent honors and awards include: Excellence in Commercialization Award, Colorado Cleantech Industry Association, 2012; Elected Fellow, American Association for the Advancement of Science, 2012; and the Presidential Green Chemistry Challenge Award, sponsored by EPA/ACS, 2015.
